

There were 1,239,551 people with diabetes registered on the NDSS

Diabetes Type	Number	%	Registered in Past Year
Type 1	118,812	10%	3,145
Type 2	1,075,677	86%	65,143
Gestational*	37,493	3%	37,493
Other	7,569	< 1%	972
Total	1,239,551	100%	106,753

<sup>\*</sup> An additional 122,833 women who previously had gestational diabetes are registered on the NDSS. These women are at high risk of developing type 2 diabetes and receive regular reminder letters to have a diabetes check.

## All People With Diabetes by Age Group



Over the last 12 months 106,753 people with diabetes were registered

Equivalent to 292 new registrants every day

Of these, 178 new registrants had type 2 diabetes and 9 had type 1 diabetes

8,135 people with diabetes were aged 15 years or under

16,234 people with diabetes were aged 20 years or under

29,711 people with diabetes were aged 21 to 29 years old

68,663 people with diabetes were aged 30 to 39 years old

791,040 people with diabetes were aged 60 years or older
